Each speaker will partner with a scientist from GEO AquaWatch. Together, they will co-develop a peer mentoring programme and presentation, which will be shared through a series of webinars to the wider GEO AquaWatch network beginning in September 2024, to be hosted by a renown Earth Observation academic.
